As electric potential is lost or gained, work is done changing the energy of some system. The amount of work in joules is given by the product of the charge that has moved, in coulombs, and the potential difference that has been crossed, in volts. Electrical energy is



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usually sold by the kilowatt-hour ($1 \text{ kW} \cdot \text{h} = 3.6 \text{ MJ}$) which is the product of the power
