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The Home Energy Station III uses natural gas and an onboard reformer to separate out the hydrogen for refueling the car. In order to create energy, it runs the hydrogen through a fuel cell and can thus

The system reforms natural gas to extract up to 3 normal cubic meters per hour (Nm³/hr) of hydrogen, which is stored in an internal tank. This hydrogen is stored for later use by the vehicle, and can also

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
