Our Sun pumps about 386 billion million gigawatts into space, mostly in the form of electromagnetic radiation. By comparison, a large nuclear

Its value is approximately 1,361 watts per square meter (W/m^2). This number represents the average amount of energy received on a surface perpendicular to the Sun's rays at Earth's

Solar energy is radiation from the Sun that is capable of producing heat, causing chemical reactions, or generating electricity.
