"Days of sunshine per year" refers to how many days have sunlight. Yuma, Arizona, is the sunniest city in the U.S., with about 401 sunny days

The Duration of Darkness table provides, for each calendar date, the total time that the entire Sun is below the horizon. Typically (for low and mid-latitude locations), this will be the sum of two elapsed
