Overview Production and Consumption Transmission Connection to the rest of Europe Distribution Competition Iceland's electricity is produced almost entirely from renewable energy sources: hydroelectric (70%) and geothermal (30%). Less than 0.02% of electricity generated came from fossil fuels (in this case, fuel oil). In 2013 a pilot wind power project was installed by Landsvirkjun, consisting of two 77m high turbines with an output of 1.8MW. There are plans to increase wind power share in Iceland, with many onshore and offshore
