After that, run make pkg to create a .pkg install file. You can also set the environment variable PS3LOAD=tcp:x.x.x.x to the PS3's IP address; that will allow you to use make run and send pkgi

apt-get install pv -y Step 2: After completion, the install command exits and instructs the user to restart the running instances of pv if it is running already.

How to install PKG files over USB Once you've downloaded your files onto your PC, drag and drop them onto your chosen portable drive's root.
