The additional capacity means Rough can store up to 6 days of average UK gas use. Centrica's long-term ambition is to turn the Rough gas

Rough, which provides 44% of the UK's natural gas storage capacity, plays a crucial role in ensuring the country's energy security. By storing gas

An essential part of the infrastructure area of the Centrica family, Centrica Energy Storage (CES+) operates the Rough gas storage facility in the Southern North Sea and the

The long-term planning for the Rough storage site is to become Europe's largest long-duration energy storage facility, initially for methane and ultimately for hydrogen with the Rough field

Energy giant Centrica was given permission this summer by the Government and regulators to reopen the ageing off-shore Rough gas storage

Centrica's long-term aim is to turn the Rough gas field into the largest long duration energy storage facility in Europe, capable of storing both natural gas and hydrogen. The UK has

The recent contract awarded to Wood by Centrica Energy Storage (CES) for the redevelopment of the UK's Rough field marks a significant step toward future hydrogen storage.

Decommissioning of a disused platform at the UK's largest gas storage facility, run by Centrica at the depleted Rough gas field off the Yorkshire

Rough is the largest offshore gas storage facility in the UK, owned and operated by Centrica-subsiary Centrica Storage (CSL). Originally a gas

Centrica has said that Rough can balance the British energy system in the short term by storing gas when there is a surplus and then withdraw gas

Centrica's long-term ambition is to turn Rough into the largest long duration low carbon energy storage facility in the world, capable of storing both

Centrica has nearly doubled available gas storage at its Rough gas storage, located off the coast of East Yorkshire (United Kingdom), in an attempt to improve the UK's energy resilience for the

Following further engineering work and investment, Rough can now store up to 54bn ft³ of gas - enough to heat 2.4m homes over the winter -

Centrica has stopped injecting natural gas into the Rough facility in the North Sea as it awaits clarity over regulatory support for hydrogen storage.

Before Rough was brought back on stream, just five days of gas demand could be met by storage in the UK, according to energy consultancy

Centrica Energy Storage (CES+) has selected Exceed as a Tier 1 partner, alongside Wood, for front-end engineering for the redevelopment of the Rough
