Triads 2022/23 In accordance with the Connection and Use of System Code (CUSC), the Triads for each charging year are calculated and published by National Grid Electricity System

In all likelihood, most of our business energy customers won't notice when TNUoS transmission fees are incurred during the Triad period. However,

The Triad refers to the three half-hour settlement periods with highest system demand between November and February, separated by at least ten clear days. National Grid uses the Triad to

"Those costs are recovered via the Triad scheme. It works as a stratified cost recovery where the customers who use the most pay the most in transmission

Ultimately, the only way that organisations can effectively deal with the cost of Triads is to look at their wider energy strategy. This involves assessing how much energy is consumed, when it is consumed

This methodology would calculate a rate that was specific to each customer - those consuming more electricity during the peak period would pay
