UN3536 is the UN ID for lithium batteries installed in cargo transport unit. There is one entry in the DOT Hazardous Materials Table for UN3536. UN3536 - Hazard

International Maritime Dangerous Goods (IMDG) Code. It is applicable to large-scale Battery Energy Storage System Ion Batteries Installed in Cargo Transport Unit). lithium batteries or lithium battery

If the primary function of the unit is energy storage, it is almost always treated as UN3536. Empty containers without batteries can be shipped as general cargo.

This classification applies exclusively to lithium-ion batteries installed within cargo transport units - including containers, vehicles, or other
