The Holy See and Italy have signed an agreement to build a solar energy plant in the Vatican's Santa Maria di Galeria area just outside of Rome,

Pope Francis, a vocal campaigner for action against climate change and on environmental protection, on Wednesday ordered the construction of a

The project aims to meet the full energy needs of both the Vatican State and Vatican Radio using solar technology integrated with agricultural activity.

Vatican City is set to become the eighth country in the world to generate 100 per cent of its electricity from renewable energy after Pope Francis

The Vatican was set to go green on Wednesday with the activation of a new solar energy system to power several key buildings and a commitment to use renewable energy for 20 percent of

In a letter released on June 21 entitled "Brother Sun" Pope Francis announced his intention to transition Vatican City onto 100% renewable energy

Italy agreed Thursday to a Vatican plan to turn a 430-hectare (1,000-acre) field north of Rome, once the source of controversy between the two, into a vast solar farm.

The installation of solar panels on Vatican-owned land to the north of the capital follows the photovoltaic glazing of the Cortile delle Corazze and the Vignaccia

Solar energy plays an essential role in Pope Francis' strategy to address climate change. Since his 2015 encyclical "Laudato Si'," the Pope has

Vatican City, the seat of Catholic papacy, has completed its move to solar-powered energy following the completion of its agrivoltaic plant situated on the Holy See's property at Santa

The Vatican is set to become the world's first carbon-neutral state through a groundbreaking initiative that involves transforming a 1,000-acre field

This tradition got a recent boost. The late Pope Francis' goal of powering the Vatican by 100% solar energy is happening now as Vatican City

Italy has agreed to a Vatican plan to turn a 430-hectare (1,000-acre) plot of land north of Rome into a vast solar farm that will generate enough

Pope Francis outlined his green vision for the Vatican in his "Brother Sun" letter in June. In it he said solar panels would be installed on a Vatican

"We must make a transition towards a model of sustainable development that reduces greenhouse gas emissions into the atmosphere, to achieve the objective of climate neutrality," the

That's because Vatican City is soon set to generate 100 percent of its electricity from renewable energy, with Pope Francis announcing plans to build

With the Apostolic Letter "Fratello sole," issued motu proprio, Pope Francis provides for the construction of an agrivoltaic plant in the extraterritorial

Pope Francis has announced plans for the Vatican City to go solar through his latest motu proprio titled Fratello Sole, or Brother Sun.

The Vatican and the Italian government sign an agreement to build an agrovoltaic plant in Santa Maria di Galeria and move towards net zero.

Vatican City has joined Albania, Bhutan, Nepal, Paraguay, Iceland, Ethiopia and the Democratic Republic of Congo to become one of just eight countries in the world to generate 100%

To achieve his aim, solar panels will be installed on a Vatican-owned property outside Rome. The power generated could supply all of Vatican City's energy needs.

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
